

About the textbook

Part 1

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This part comprises of 5 units. The Hiragana script is covered in first 3 Units. While Katakana is covered in Unit 4, simple introduction of kanji characters is covered in Unit 5. Every Unit of this part has Information corner section which provides information about the Japan and various topics relating to Japan. The structure of each unit is as follows.

Part 2

This part contains the Main text. There are 5 lessons. Each lesson is structured as follows.

- 4. Kanji characters of verbs, adjectives
- 5. Kanji characters of direction, positions
- 6. Generic Kanji characters

Each unit has practice sheets and exercises. The readings of the kanji characters and Jukugo words (words of kanji character combinations) for practice are covered.
