Form groups of 8 to 10 children each to play this game.

• The first child says,



I went to the market.

Do you know what I bought?

Some red shiny apples!

That's what I got.

• The second child adds something:



I went to the market.

Do you know what I bought?

Some red shiny apples!

A big loaf of bread!

That's what I got.

• The third child adds one more thing.



I went to the market.

Do you know what I bought?

Some red shiny apples!

A big loaf of bread!

A pack of colour pencils!

That's what I got.









In this way, every child repeats in the correct order, what others have said and adds something new on his/her own. The game continues up to the last child.
