Form groups of 8 to 10 children each to play this game.

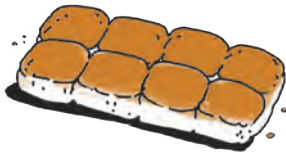
- The first child says,

- The second child adds something :

I went to the market.
Do you know what I bought ?
Some red shiny apples !
A big loaf of bread !
That's what I got.



- The third child adds one more thing.

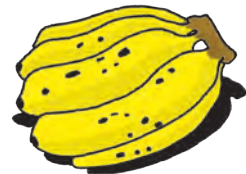
I went to the market.
Do you know what I bought ?
Some red shiny apples !
A big loaf of bread !
A pack of colour pencils !
That's what I got.



A string of white flowers



A bunch of big bananas



A big jar of honey



A sack of gram flour



A pack of liquid soap



Some juicy ripe mangoes



A pair of blue bangles



In this way, every child repeats in the correct order, what others have said and adds something new on his/her own. The game continues up to the last child.
