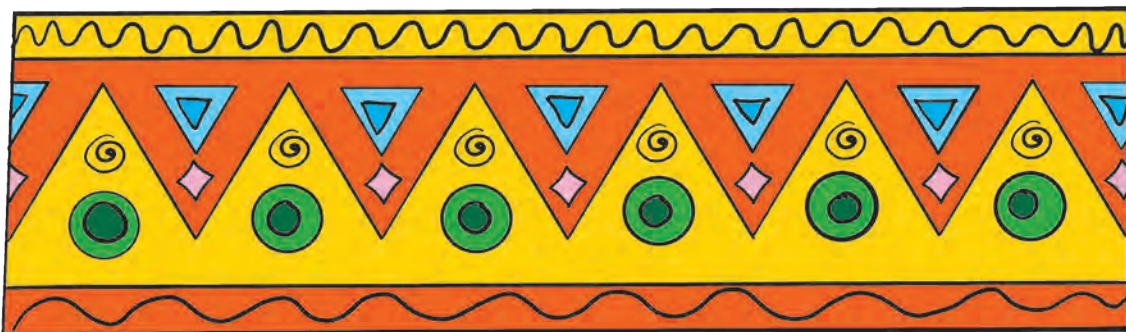
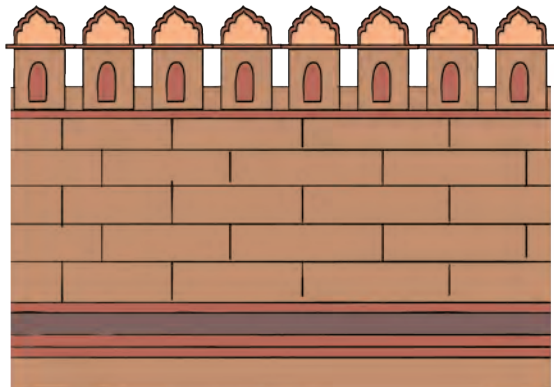
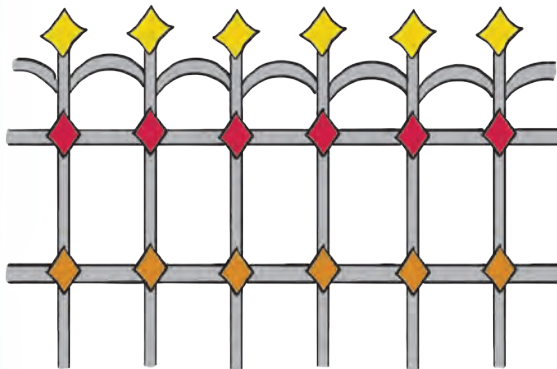
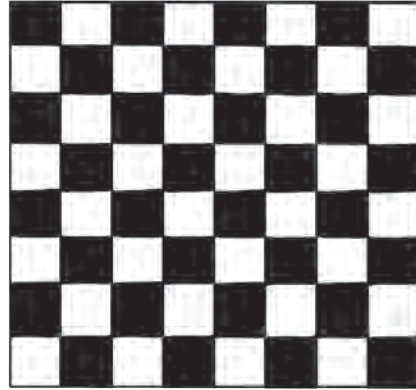
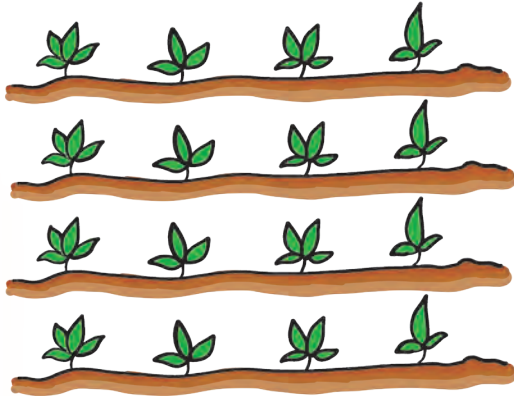


Patterns

Observe the patterns shown below. We see many such patterns in our surroundings.

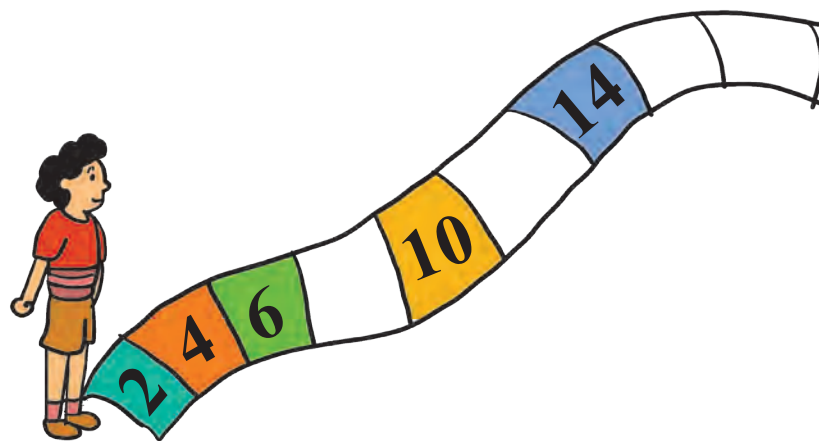


Activity :

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Complete the pattern shown in the picture below.

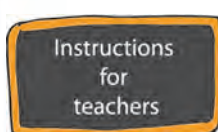
